Verses to study:

lost... for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost Luke 19:10

have gone astray... All we like **sheep have gone astray**; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him [Jesus] the iniquity of us all. Isaiah 53:6

in the dark... And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and **men loved darkness** rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For everyone practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed. John 3:19-20; Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in **darkness**, but have the light of life." John 8:12; For you were once **darkness**...And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of **darkness**,

but rather expose them. For it is shameful even to speak of those things which are done by them in secret. Ephesians 5:8, 11-12; He has delivered us from the power of **darkness** Colossians 1:13; that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of **darkness** into His marvelous light; who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy 1 Peter 2:9-10

perishing...For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing 1 Corinthians 1:18

blind...But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, whose minds the god of this age has **blinded**, who do not believe 2 Corinthians 4:3-4

*children of wrath...*the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience, among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature **children of wrath**, just as the others Ephesians 2:2-3

dead in our trespasses and sin... And you He made alive, who were **dead in trespasses and sins** Ephesians 2:1; But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were **dead in trespasses**, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved). Ephesians 2:4-5

enemies of God... For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. Romans 5:10; Because the carnal mind is enmity against God...So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God. Romans 8:7-8; having abolished in His flesh the enmity...and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity Ephesians 2:15-16; And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works Colossians 1:21

disobedient...For we ourselves were also once foolish, *disobedient*, deceived, serving various lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful and hating one another. Titus 3:3

unrighteous... As it is written: "There is **none righteous**, no, not one; there is none who understands; there is none who seeks after God. Romans 3:10-11; But we are all like an unclean thing, and all our **righteousnesses are like filthy rags**. Isaiah 64:6

ungodly... For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. Romans 5:6

not good... So He [Jesus] said to him, "Why do you call Me good? No one is good but One, that is, God. Matthew 19:17; They have all turned aside; they have together become unprofitable; there is **none who does** good, no, not one." Romans 3:12

condemned...Therefore, as through one man's [Adam] offense judgment came to all men, resulting in condemnation. Romans 5:18; "He who believes in Him [Jesus] is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. John 3:18

subject to the wrath of God... For the **wrath of God** is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness. Romans 1:18: but to those who are self-seeking and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness—**indignation and wrath**, tribulation and anguish, on every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek Romans 2:8-9: Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and **wrath of Almighty God**. And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF **KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS**. Revelation 19:11-16

without hope... at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, **having no hope** and without God in the world Ephesians 2:12

*all sinners...*But the Scripture has confined **all under sin**, that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe. Galatians 3:22; for **all have sinned** and fall short of the glory of God Romans 3:23

slaves of sin... knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we **should no longer be slaves of sin** Romans 6:6; But God be thanked that though **you were slaves of sin**, yet you obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine to which you were delivered. Romans 6:17

fallen short of the glory of God... for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God Romans 3:23

hard-hearted... For the hearts of this people have grown dull. Their ears are hard of hearing, and their eyes they have closed, lest they should see with their eyes and hear with their ears, lest they should understand with their hearts and turn, so that I should heal them. Matthew 13:15; But in accordance with your hardness and your impenitent heart you are treasuring up for yourself wrath in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God, who "will render to each one according to his deeds. Romans 2:5-6; This I say, therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should no longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk, in the futility of their mind, having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart; who, being past feeling, have given themselves over to lewdness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. Ephesians 4:17-19

*far off from God...*But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. Ephesians 2:13
